## Expressive Art and Design

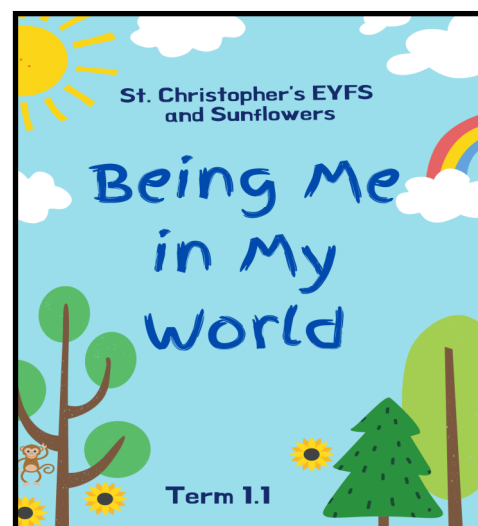
- Dance—exploring different genres of music

## Physical Development

- Controlling tools and equipment—self service snack, scissor skills.
- Exploring the outdoor space—bikes, sand pit, building, gardening
- Gross motor skills—Moving in different ways e.g. crawling, running, walking/holding a balance
- Learning about their bodies—body parts

## Mathematical Development

- Counting 'how many'? E.g. how many people have blue eyes?
- Comparing groups of objects
- Comparing objects e.g. tallest building etc
- Exploring simple repeating patterns
